The teacher training seminar will be held at Severn Run Evangelical Presbyterian Church, 1624 Millersville Road, Millersville, MD 21108 (just around the corner from our school). Rockbridge Academy is conveniently located between Baltimore and Annapolis, 15 minutes from BWI airport. The area is rich in historical and cultural activities with Washington, D.C., historic Annapolis, and the city of Baltimore, all within a short driving distance of the school.

July 19-23, 2010. Monday, July 19th is an optional teacher training field trip to Gettysburg National Military Battlefield Park. Formal teacher training starts at Severn Run EP Church on Tuesday, July 20th. Please arrive by 7:30 a.m. on Tuesday to pick up materials. The seminars will normally run from 7:50 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. The Friday session will be dismissed at lunch.

PLENARY SESSIONS

The conference will include plenary sessions that will address broad areas of the vision, focus, and application of classical and Christian education from a biblical worldview.

Workshops will cover a variety of topics of particular interest to the classical Christian educator at the Grammar, Dialectic, and Rhetoric levels. ## GETTYSBURG FIELD TRIP

This is an optional activity for any who are interested and will incur an additional \$45 fee per attendee. The cost of the Gettysburg Teacher Training includes a National Defense University-trained docent for the entire battlefield tour, a study guide, continental breakfast, lunch, and transportation. Meet at Severn Run EP Church, depart at 7:00 a.m. and return at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 19, 2010.

The purpose of the day is to help teachers bring history to life for students, plan field trips, use history to drive home character and leadership with students, and guide students to view history in terms of motivation, context, and outcomes, all with a biblical worldview.

## LUNCH

Lunch is provided by Rockbridge Academy on Tuesday, July 20th to encourage fellowship and meet Rockbridge Academy teachers. Training attendees should plan to travel a short distance for lunch Wednesday through Friday. There are several fast-food and eat-in restaurants within 5 minutes of the training facility.

## DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS NORTH AND WEST:

Baltimore beltway, I-695, to I-97 south. Follow to Exit 10A, Benfield Blvd east. Turn right onto Veterans Hwy. Go approximately 2 miles to turn left onto Generals Hwy. (MD 178). Go approximately 1 mile to first traffic light and turn right at Millersville Rd. Severn Run EP Church is approximately 1 mile on the right.

## DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS SOUTH AND WEST:

I-95 north to Washington beltway toward Baltimore. Take Exit 19A, US 50, toward Annapolis. Take Exit 13B, MD-3, toward Crofton. Merge onto MD-3 toward Crofton. Go approximately 8 miles and turn right onto Millersville Rd (MD-175). Go approximately 1 mile and Severn Run EP Church will be on your left.

## DIRECTIONS FROM POINTS EAST:

US-50 west. Take Exit 21, I-97 north, toward Baltimore. Take Exit 7, MD-32 west/MD-3 south Columbia/Bowie, toward Bowie. Merge onto MD-3 south toward Gambrills/Bowie. Turn left onto Millersville Road (MD-175). Go approximately 1 mile and Severn Run EP Church will be on your left.

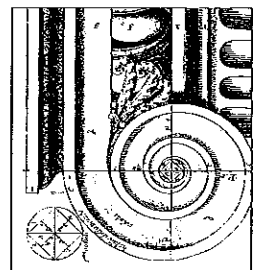

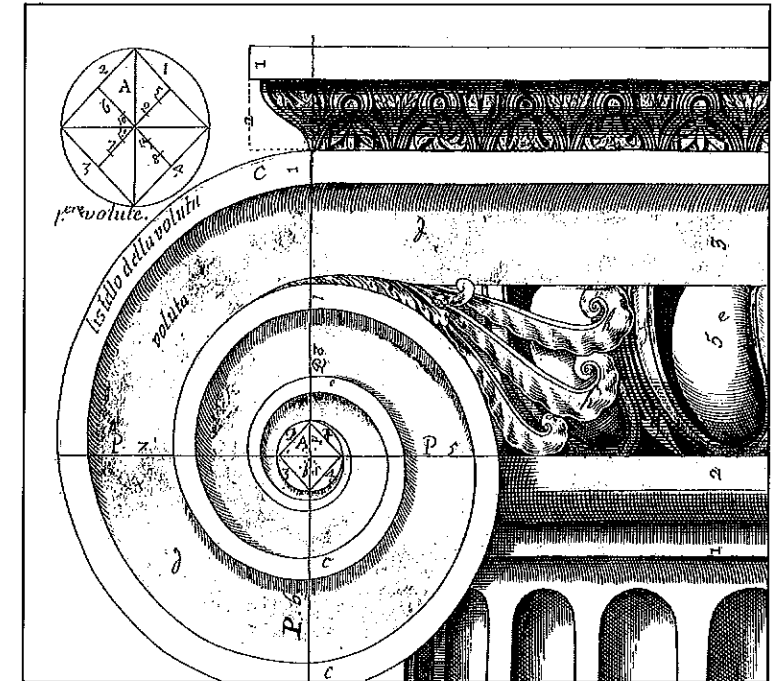
